General Rules of Conduct

The guiding principles of the Troop 47 rules of conduct are contained in the Scout Oath and the Scout Law. It is expected that every Scout will strive to follow these guidelines at all times.

All Scouts and adults will comply with the Boy Scouts of America rules and regulations as set forth in the "Guide to Safe Scouting" as well as in other publications. More detailed Troop 47 information is included in the Troop 47 Policy and Procedures. Most of all, all Scouts are expected to exercise good judgment and common sense.

Each scout is expected to behave in a manner such that he will help advance the programs of Troop 47. Disruptive behavior will not be tolerated. Scouts are entitled to a program which is free of such behavior.

The Patrol Leader's Council and the Scoutmaster will enforce the general rules of conduct. At their discretion, each infraction will be handled in an appropriate manner, which may include sending the Scout home from any scouting activity, including campouts. The scout's parents will be responsible for picking the scout up at the activity.
